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## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF PRE-EMPOWERED COMMITTEE FOR PMGSY HELD ON 26th February, 2016.

## STATE: UTTARAKHAND

A meeting of Pre-Empowered Committee was held on 26th February, 2016 at 11.00 AM under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (RC) to discuss the project proposals of the State of Uttarakhand under PMGSY. List of participants is given below:

- DPR Issues: Director (Tech), NRRDA mentioned the following DPR issues before Pre-EC 3. meeting:
  - After scrutiny and advise of NRRDA the State has reworked the proposals and the total cost has been scaled down by Rs. 12.66 Crores.
  - The average proposed cost is still on the higher side in certain proposals pertaining to Stage I, II and Full stage (20 Nos) and the state needs to further review this.
  - The pavement design in the proposals must be based on IRC SP-72 2015, Guidelines for the Design of Flexible pavements for Low Volume Rural Roads. This would further reduce the cost of construction.

- URRDA needs to verify and certify that, proposed GSB for Stage II works has not been included
  in the already sanctioned Stage I DPR.
- CBR and Traffic details have not been entered for many roads which are proposed for Stage II
  and Complete construction.
- The State has to propose 94 Km under New technology (focussing on cold mix and waste plastic
  on a priority basis), as per new technology initiative guidelines whereas State has proposed only
  17.70 Km under new technology, It needs to be increased.
- Earth work cutting seems to be on higher side. In most of the cases, Ruling Gradient have been
  adopted for the entire length of the roads. The State may explore the possibility to change some
  portions of the roads to acceptable gradient as per expert committees' recommendations.
- Cross drainage works proposed is on higher side and it needs to be justified wrt to L Section and X Section drawings.
- State should confirm that no CD structures were sanctioned under Stage 1 at those locations
  where stage 11 proposals have been formulated.
- CBR, Traffic details, Proforma C and photographs of all proposals not yet uploaded on OMMAS.
- JS(RC) pointed out that the average cost in comparison to the last two financial year is on
  the higher side and needs to be reduced. A revised comparative table of Average Cost to be
  furnished by the State before EC.
- 5. R&D proposals: As per technology initiative guidelines 15% (10% with IRC specifications and 5% without IRC specifications) length have to be proposed under R&D technology. The total road length proposed under R&D head is less than 15% and therefore needs to be enhanced.
- 6. Quality issues: Director (P-III), NRRDA pointed out that two inspections of road works are yet to be carried out by SQMs, which are more than 12 months old. In 5 Packages, labs are yet to be established and 15 labs although established are not fully functional. 5 ATR's are still pending from the year 2014-15. The State is required to submit pending ATR before the next EC meeting.
- 7. Maintenance issues: The details of maintenance fund required, release of maintenance fund to SRRDA its utilization during the current financial year was also discussed. URRDA has received 100% of maintenance fund against which expenditure is 50% upto December, 2015 has been done. State officials assured that URRDA intends to utilize entire available funds before March, 2016.
- 8. Financial issues: Director (F&A), NRRDA pointed out that Internal Audit Report has not been submitted by the State to NRRDA. State needs to take action for financial closure of 115 number of physically completed works. In addition, interest earned on Term Deposits to be intimated to NRRDA. State needs to furnish a Term Deposit a Certificate to NRRDA.
- The State will complete the following activities and following that request the Ministry to schedule an early date for Empowered Committee meeting:

- The State will upload DPRs of 189 Road works on OMMAS (duly approved by STAs) 1.
- The State will include atleast 2 bridges of new design & technology in the present proposals. 11.
- The State will include at least 5% of road works under R&D . 111.
- The State will submit a revised comparative table of Average Cost. IV.
- The State would update the maintenance status on OMMAS. V.
- Action should be taken to send status of pending 5 ATRs of the year 2014-15 and upload the VI. status on OMMAS.
- The State will take steps to set the remaining 5 labs make the already existent 15 labs functional. VII.
- The State will inform the Ministry of interest earned on Programme fund Term Deposit VIII. Certificate for.
- The State will submit a justification for increase in average cost per km of current proposal. IX.
- The State will send a compliance report on all the issues indicated above to the Ministry/NRRDA before seeking date for EC meeting.
