1. It is noticed that progress of the state in eMARG is very slow and till date no maintenance related payments have been made for the workable packages on eMARG.
2. The status of the eMARG activities as on 14<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020 is as follows:

3. As you are aware, one of the prerequisites for PMGSY III is that states have to be on board and make maintenance related payments through eMARG portal. Further, the criteria for awarding incentives to the states are dependent on proper maintenance of roads by the states through eMARG. Also, as per Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India instructions, w.e.f. 01 April, 2020, all maintenance related payments shall be made via eMARG only.
4. Keeping the above in view, the state is urged to complete the requisite steps for on boarding eMARG and start making payments using the eMARG portal at the earliest failing which sanction in PMGSY-III will be hampered.
