

Reference is invited to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 20th April, 2020, wherein targets for saturation of 5,108 habitations and construction of 66,784 Km road length under various interventions of PMGSY during the year 2020-21 were communicated to the States/UTs. However, in the wake of disruptions caused due to Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent requests by the State Governments/UTs for revision of targets, the physical targets for the year 2020-21 have been revised with the approval of the competent authority and have been indicated in the Annexure.
