Subject: Revised Guidelines of Financial Incentives.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 13.10.2016 and 22.11.2016 vide which it was intimated that top-one third performing States would become eligible to receive financial incentives at the end of the financial year on the basis of the their performance upto December. It was also clarified that the funds released as financial incentives would be used for periodic maintenance of rural roads already constructed under PMGSY.

2. The Ministry has now decided to revise the financial incentive parameters as well as the corresponding weightage percentage. The parameters and their corresponding weightage decided by the Competent Authority are as under:


Parameters	Weightage	Revised Weightage
Achievement of target length during the year	30%	25%
Achievement of target Habitations during the year	30%	25%
Length constructed under New Technology during the year	15%	10%
Quality of road (Submission of ATRs of NQMs)	10%	-
OMMAS data entry	5%	-
Maintenance policy	10%	-
Expenditure on maintenance of roads within DLP *	-	15%
Length renewed during post DLP - % renewed #	-	15%
Inspection of maintenance work - NQM inspections	-	10%

* Percentage of expenditure incurred as against the requirement for maintenance of roads within DLP.

Length of roads renewed post 5 year DLP (cumulative length renewed as against total road length post DLP)

3. In view of above, States are requested to update the OMAAS data on regular basis, as all the data for financial incentive calculation would be obtained from OMMAS only.

4. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
