Subject: Release of Rs. 215.35 crore as 1st tranche of 2nd installment of Programme Fund and Rs. 4.65 crore as 1st tranche of 1st installment of Administrative Fund under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) as Grants-in-aid to State Government of Bihar for the financial year 2023-24.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for release of an amount of **Rs 220,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred and Twenty Crores only)** to the State Government of Bihar as as Central assistance under **Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)** for the financial year 2023-24 as per the details given below:

Note: The State Government of Bihar is required to release corresponding state share of Rs. 3.10 crore against Admin Fund release into SNA account.

2. The amount of **Rs. 215.35 crores** is adjusted as per the details given in the table below:

3. The State Government shall transfer these funds along with corresponding State Share to Bihar Rural Roads Development Agency (BRRDA), Rural Works Department, Bihar within a maximum period of 30 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of delay beyond 30 days in transfer of central share to the SNA account, interest will be charged at the rate of 7% per annum. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

4. Bihar Rural Roads Development Agency (BRRDA) has nominated Shri Sanjay Dubey, Additional Chief Executive Officer-cum-Secretary, BRRDA, Patna, Bihar as Empowered Officer.

5. The funds will be transferred by the State Government to Bihar Rural Roads Development Agency (BRRDA) shall be kept in separate **Savings Bank Account No. 00000011111137916 (IFSC Branch No. SBIN0006379), State Bank of India, Bailey Road Branch, Patna, Bihar**. Implementing Agencies (IAs) down the ladder should use the SNA's account with clearly defined drawing limits set for that account. It shall be ensured by the State Government that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana as per the limit assigned. The Empowered Officer of the **Bihar Rural Roads Development Agency (BRRDA)** shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the bank regarding the names of authorized payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.

7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from **Bihar Rural Roads Development Agency (BRRDA)**.

8. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in term of Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme- specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.

9. The State Government shall ensure the integration of the state treasury with PFMS and all the entries should be reflected on PFMS before the request of further funds release.

10. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that sufficient budget provisions are made in the state budget before the request of further funds release.

11. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of **Rule 236(1)** of the General Financial Rules.


12. The expenditure is debitabale to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No. 87** Department of Rural Development (2023-24):-
